2. Nitrate Concentrations in Source Waters Linda Kinman, DMWW
Mike McCurnin, DMWW

Nitrate concentrations have exceeded the EPA's Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) of 10 mg/L in the Raccoon and Des Moines Rivers since late April 2013. Linda Kinman, Public Policy Analyst/Watershed Advocate for Des Moines Water Works, and Mike McCurnin, Director of Water Production at Des Moines Water Works, will give an overview of how nitrate concentrations get to our source water, what Des Moines Water Works has done to battle historic nitrate concentrations, and ideas on what could be done to combat increasing nitrate trends in Iowa's source waters in recent years.
